Dear Blackwater Parents and Guardians,

Welcome back to another exciting semester at BWCS! We are so happy to see all the students back after the holidays.


All students in kindergarten through fifth grade took middle of the year assessments prior to winter break. They took NWEA, an online assessment, for reading and math. NWEA is an intuitive assessment that adjusts to each students' level to determine precisely what skills they have mastered and where they need extra support. Teachers use this information to group students with similar needs for small groups.

Students also took DIBELS, a one-minute reading assessment. DIBELS is given individually to each student. This assessment provides teachers with additional information regarding letter names/sounds, phonemic awareness, phonics, reading fluency and comprehension, depending on grade level.

If you have any questions or concerns regarding the assessments or your child's scores, please speak with your child's teacher. They can share the results, letting you know your child's strengths and where they need a little extra help.

Please take a few minutes to talk with your child/ren daily about their day. Ask them what they are learning in math and what story they are reading. Ask what is one thing that made them proud or happy. And of course, ask if they have homework. These easy conversations let your child know that you care about their education.
